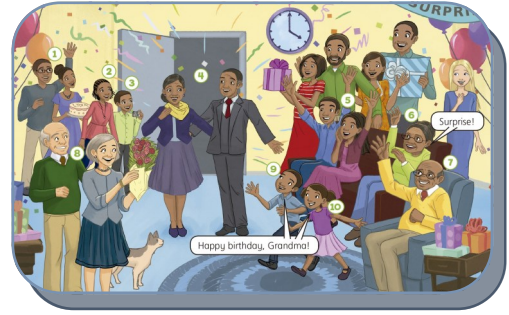

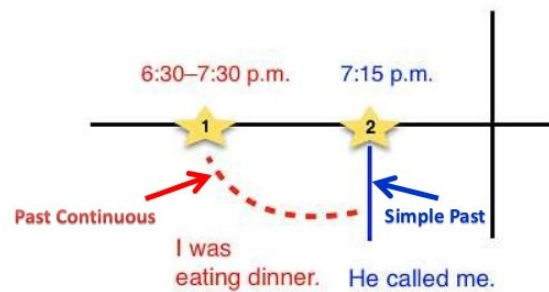

3. Read the story "FAMILY TRIP TO LONDON"

TOUR ITINERARY:

Sunday -

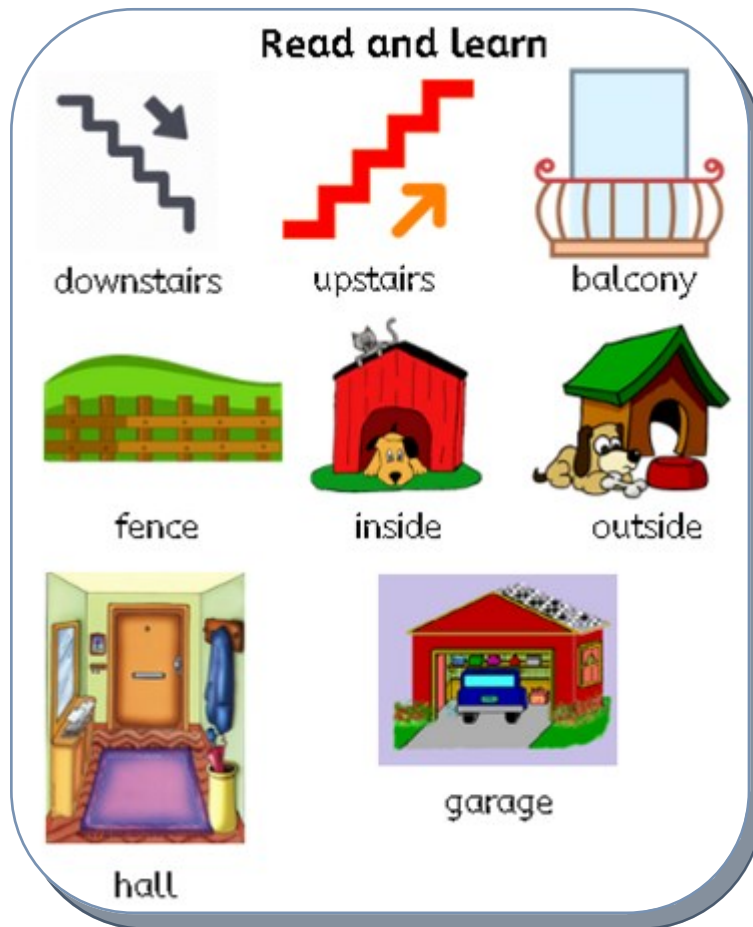
